The Master's programme in Digital Governance and Administration (DiGA) prepares students for leadership positions related to the digital transformation of the public sector and beyond. The programme focuses on the interplay between humans, organisations and digital technology. Students learn to analyse societal challenges in a changing global environment from a social science perspective, and to contribute to the development and implementation of solutions using digital technologies. The interdisciplinary programme combines social science modules in public administration and business management with computer and data science. A high degree of flexibility and elective modules enable students to specialise according to their personal experience and interests.
