## WISE-AEGIS: serious game about Resilience and Civil Preparedness in the Baltic Sea Region

WISE-AEGIS is a wargame that focuses on a nation's resilience and its ability to withstand shocks. The game focuses on the importance of Resilience through Civil Preparedness and the responsibilities of various actors within this context. In the game, participants take on different roles (e.g. government leader, diplomat, NATO Resilience Liaison, commercial sector representatives, etc.). Players play as nations in teams. They are challenged to not only work together within their own team, but also with other teams and entities such as NATO Liaison Committee and the EU Emergency Response Coordination Centre.

WISE-AEGIS can be played up to 40 participants. The wargame is currently used within the NATO CIMIC Centre of Excellence for many of its courses, incl. NATO CIMIC Higher Command Course. It has been developed in collaboration with the Joint Warfare Centre. During the 90-minutes workshop, participants are also challenged to relate their in-game experiences to various key concepts related to:

- 1. game-based learning within the armed forces, and
- resilience through civil preparedness, democracy, whole-ofgovernment approach and the role of NATO within national decision-making.

The game is delivered by two experts from the CCOE.
